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10th Anniversary Interuniversity Seminar "Lingvo cultural area studies: methods of analysis, education technology", held at the Moscow State Institute of International Relations (MSIIR (U)) (MGIMO(U)) from June 14 to June 15, 2012

From 14 to 15 June at the Moscow State Institute of International Relations (MSIIR(U)) hosted the 10th Anniversary Interuniversity Seminar "lingvocultural area studies: methods of analysis, education technology." Workshop Topic: "Category courtesy ethnolinguistic space."

At the plenary session were: Vice President for Academic Affairs, Professor of MSIIR (U). V.B. Kirillov, Chairman of the Scientific and Methodological Council (University) Prof. G.I. Gladkov, prof. L.G. Vedenina.

On the anniversary conference were invited eminent scientists of the Russian Federation: NI Basovskaya, Dr. of Historical Sciences, Professor., Head World History Department of the Russian State Humanitarian University, member of the "Academy", speaking to the fundamental on the topic: "Autumn of the Middle Ages in Western Europe and the origins of national identity in England and France." When listening to her colleagues were able to view the report in the full sense of the word, not only the depth and breadth N.I. Basov's knowledge, but her extraordinary oratory gift.

At the plenary session spoke on TM Nikolayev, corresponding member of the Russian Academy of Sciences, member of the Göttingen Academy, editor of the journal "Problems of Linguistics," on "New Approaches to the grammar of the text." Report features the original and innovative campaign to address the problems associated with the grammar of the text with commentary by professional research experience T.M .Nikolaeva, allowing deeper and more serious to understand the concept proposed by the author.

It is important to say that the inspirer and organizer of the 10th Anniversary of intercollegiate seminar ": methods of analysis lingvo cultural area studies, technology education," is over ten years old Lyudmila Vedenina, which deserves mention. Lyudmila G., Ph.D., Professor of French (University), a member of the Paris Linguistic Society and the International Society of functional linguistics, is one of the founders of the domestic lingvo cultural area studies, an active organizer and participant in numerous scientific seminars and conferences, both in Russia and abroad. For contribution to the theoretical development and teaching lingvo cultural area studies awarded the State Prize of the Russian Federation (2002) and the title of Knight of the French Order of Academic Palm Branches (2003).

Prof. Lyudmila Vedenina fundamentally summarized in the report of the Inter-University decadelong workshop "lingvo cultural area studies: methods of analysis, education technology," which was illustrated by the educational documentary, filmed for the anniversary conference participants and guests.

The speech Lyudmila finished with popular expression in Latin: «Feci quod potui faciant meliora potentes» - «I did everything I could, who can, let him do better."

The seminar was attended by colleagues not only from Russia, but from many other countries (Austria, Germany, France, UK, etc).

Three sections: Languages in the aspect lingvo area studies (section 1), Problems of didactics (section 2), Category politeness in linguistic space (section 3). At the third section meeting were made reports devoted to the category of politeness in the Near and Middle East (Turkey Arabic, Chinese, Vietnamese, Laotian, Thai culture, and the culture of Japan, Korea, Mongolia, the

Philippines, Indonesia, etc.). This broad cultures and languages scope in itself tells about the great scientific interest to the problem of politeness in different languages and cultures. In this connection it is interesting to emphasize that 53 languages are taught at the University (this fact is mentioned in the Guinness Records Book).

The Round Table meeting, which was summed up by interesting and action-oriented workshop. Participation in the workshop strengthened the pedagogical and scientific contacts with colleagues (University), from various universities in Russia and abroad, exchange scientific and pedagogical experience, discuss possible joint lingvo area studies projects, etc.
